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Research and Translation Information

Research fees are \$30/hour for Museum members (to take advantage of the member rate become a member online at www.danishmuseum.org); \$40/hour for non-members, plus postage, copying and document fees. A 2-hour minimum** retainer, payable to The Danish Immigrant Museum, and a completed Research Request Form should be sent to the above address. Some inquiries can be answered in this amount of time, but please also specify a maximum number of hours you wish to be spent on the search before a report is made. You will be invoiced for the remaining amount when the research is completed.

Copies of FHGC files and documents are \$.25/page, plus postage. Copies of courthouse and other documents will vary in price.

Microfilms of materials available through the Family History Library in Salt Lake City, such as Danish military records, may be borrowed for a fee. We can advise you of film numbers, but you would have to order the films online, requesting that they be sent to the FHGC. The current charge is \$5.50 per film roll.

Individuals interested in **Danish Brotherhood records** may request either a transcript of the record, which is included in the research fee, or microfilm copies (each listing takes a minimum of 2 prints; some individuals were members of lodges in various localities during their lifetime and hence have several listings).

**Searches involving Danish Brotherhood records only require a 1-hour advance search fee *per name*.

Queries are answered in the order of receipt of payment. Due to the number of requests received, our response time usually varies between 10-16 weeks. Rest assured that we will get to your inquiry as soon as possible.

Translation fees are \$30/hour for Museum members and \$40/hour for non-members, with a 1-hour minimum. Send or email a clear COPY of the original material to the address above, along with contact information. For lengthier or more involved projects we will give you an estimate of the time needed for the translation.
