Session Descriptions:

Look Before You Cross (the Atlantic)! - A presentation of common pitfalls in Danish-American research, important US resources that should be checked for information, and some less-common ones that can be useful.

You've Gotten to Denmark--Now What? - An overview of the key Danish resource groups, the main research facilities in Denmark, and the kinds of information a researcher will be able to find, even without knowing Danish.

Were They German or Danish?: An overview of the history of the Duchy of Slesvig (Schleswig) and problems and resources involving ancestors who resided there.

Cyber Genealogy -- Danish Style 1: A hands-on look at the some of the most useful online resources for Danish genealogy.

Cyber Genealogy -- Danish Style 2: More useful Danish websites to use from home.

Workshops are \$25 per session for museum members, \$35 for non-members; individual research consultations are \$10/\$15 on a first-come, first-serve basis.
