A LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

January 2008

Dear Friends and Supporters of The Danish Immigrant Museum,

In calendar year 2008, The Danish Immigrant Museum celebrates its 25th anniversary. Over the past 25 years, much has been accomplished. A tremendous thank you goes to the many dedicated people, volunteers and staff, who have made this possible. Pat yourself on the back as without you there would be no national museum in the heart of the continent. Our Danish heritage would not have been preserved to the extent it is today without you!

It is appropriate to reflect briefly on what has been accomplished. Much persistence and perspiration was expended on making the institution the fine place it is today. I think our forbearers would be proud of the work that has been done across the country to bring this effort to fruition. Being a native of the Danish Villages area (Elk Horn and Kimballton) having lived there for the first 18 years of my being, I can't help but speculate what some of the "old" Danish pioneers of these villages would say if they were able to visit the area for a day. I would envision the harness maker, the Danish baker, feed and drug store owners, grocer, veterinarian, hardware dealer and physician all shaking their heads and marveling that there is a national museum commemorating those simple, hardworking, good folks who sought to become Americans. I'll bet many "old" humble Danes around the country would react similarly – "What

did we do to deserve this"?

As my four grandparents immigrated separately to this emerging nation, I speculate what their thoughts must have been. Certainly their feelings must have been mixed. Probably immense sadness at leaving family knowing they may never see them again. I suspect there was anxiety at how they would cope in the new world probably not knowing the language. There must have been great anticipation as to what opportunities they would find. The questions and speculation could go on and on, but we all know courage had to be a strong part of the constitution of the immigrant striking out to a new life in an unfamiliar world.

The immigrant experiences of the past must be preserved! Yet as we look at the next 25 years, we need not only reflect on the immigrant experience, but our focus needs to expand to include many other aspects of our heritage. Our Danish heritage has made numerous significant contributions to a better world. Danish Americans have made wonderful contributions. Those stories also need to be told. "Across Oceans, Across Times, Across Generations" appropriately indicates some challenges of the past, but also points us in a direction to the future. Our task to capture this new mission will be complex and difficult. The task will continue to require the efforts of so many dedicated people. Another aspect needing further concentration is the method by which we bring these stories to people and places. Virtual museum technology and traveling exhibits are some of the ways the Danish story may be told in the future.

Obviously, as we look to the



A LETTER FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Twenty-five years ago, on a cold night in February 1993, a committee named by the Danish American Heritage Society to investigate sites for a museum celebrating the Danish experience in the United States met in Elk Horn at the invitation of the community. As a junior member of the committee, I remember the night well.

Over 400 people assembled in the high school gymnasium along with then Governor of Iowa Terry Branstad to make a case for why Iowa and the communities of Elk Horn and Kimballton should be the site of a national museum. The obvious enthusiasm, the demonstrated community effort in

negotiating, purchasing, moving from Denmark and reconstructing a Danish Windmill, the location along Interstate 80 and the proximity to Danish American institutions like the headquarters of The Danish Brotherhood in America located in Omaha, and Dana College and Grand View College were compelling reasons; the committee decided to recommend Elk Horn as the place.

Twenty-five years ago, we had nothing but a dream. Over the years, the dream has taken form, so that today we are an institution with almost 5 million dollars in assets. Many, many have been responsible for our success. First of all, you, our members, are primarily responsible. Since our founding, over 15,000 members and donors have supported our efforts to establish a museum and have watched us as we have grown. We are deeply grateful to each and every one of you.

While it is dangerous to identify names as one runs the risk of not identifying an individual or individuals one should, I must recognize again the family of Consul Bruce R. Lauritzen and the Lauritzen Corporation. Their generosity has enabled us to retire a debt of 1.6 million dollars. As I wrote in the 2007

summer issue of our *America Letter*, "I believe the Danish American community, whether museum members or not, owe the Lauritzens a great debt of gratitude."

The other person I want to acknowledge is Gunnar Horn, a long-time English teacher at Benson High School in Omaha; though a man of modest means, his estate gift was the seed for our Holger Danske Endowment. Today, our endowment is over 1.2 million dollars. That growth has happened because many, like Gunnar Horn, have realized that it is our endowment that will help to assure our museum will have the resources to support future annual budgets. After collecting and conserving our artifacts and sharing through our programming, continuing to grow endowment is our highest priority. I invite you to consider providing for the museum in your estate. Should you have questions concerning this or other ways in which you might support our museum, please contact us.

We continue to have ambitious dreams for The Danish Immigrant Museum. No institution can thrive without a vision for the future. This we have been sharing in exhibits, on our website, and as we travel the country. Your membership support and your contributions are a daily affirmation of our work. On behalf of the staff, we thank you and rededicate ourselves to carrying forward the mission to share "the legacy and continuing influence of Danish culture as realized in the experiences and contributions of Danish immigrants, their descendants and Danes living in America."

A HISTORY OF SUCCESS

1979 – The concept of establishing a museum devoted to the preservation of the rich traditions and culture brought to America by Danish immigrants and the stories of the Danish-American experience was born at Dana College. The vision was further defined by delegates of Danish descent to a Scandinavian Immigrant Conference meeting in Decorah, Iowa.

1980 – In response to endorsement of the concept by the Dana College Board of Regents, Arnold Bodtke, president of the Danish American Heritage Society, appointed a committee to explore the idea of creating a national museum.

1981-82 – During these years the committee met on several occasions to consider issues and study possible sites for the location of a museum that would serve Danish Americans from the entire United States.

1983 – The committee met in Elk Horn, Iowa and, at the urging and support of local residents, chose the Danish villages of Iowa as the site for The Danish Immigrant Museum because of its geographically central location.

In May, the Museum was officially incorporated and the first meeting of the founding Board of Directors was held.

In July, the Elk Horn Lutheran Church donated 20 acres for the site of the Museum.

1984 – The first Annual Meeting of The Danish Immigrant Museum was held in Elk Horn.

1985-87 – The Museum was temporarily located on Main Street, Elk Horn, and, with the hiring of an executive director, accessioning of the collection began.

1988 – A Ground Breaking Ceremony was held at the future site of the Museum.

1990 – Construction of Phase I of the Museum began. The Elk Horn-Kimballton Arts Council presented *Bedstemor's Hus* to the Museum for its continuing preservation.

1991 – Members celebrated a *Rejsegilde* (raising the traditional Danish construction wreath).

1993 – 450 persons attended a festive dinner held in the completed Phase I building to mark the 10th Anniversary of the founding of The Danish Immigrant Museum.

1994 – The permanent exhibit, *Across Oceans, Across Time*, was completed in time for the Grand Opening of the Museum in June.

1994-96 – Interior construction of the building continued with the completion of the mezzanine and the installation of an elevator. With the hiring of a full-time curator, regularly changing exhibits were introduced. The Family History and Genealogy Center opened on the mezzanine under the guidance of an all-volunteer staff.

1998-99 – The Visual Storage Area on the lower level was constructed thus allowing visitors to view the vast collection of artifacts which has been accessioned by the Museum.

2000-01 – Recognizing the need to provide for the long-term viability of the Museum, the Board of Directors established the Holger Danske Endowment.

2002 – Plans were generated for establishing an off-site location for the Family History and Genealogy Center. A full-time librarian and manager for the proposed facility was hired. Additionally, the Board of Directors approved a plan for expanding the grounds of the Museum into a natural park following the tenets of famed landscaper Jens Jensen.

2003 – The 20th Anniversary of the Museum was celebrated with a year long series of special events that included the grand opening of the new Family History and Genealogy Center in its location on Elk Horn's Main Street during the annual Tivoli Fest in May. In October, the celebration culminated with open houses and a gala dinner.

2004 – Two Danish graduate students are the first interns, as the Museum initiates an internship program with Aalborg University, the Danmark-Amerika Fonden and The American-Scandinavian Foundation. The Museum partners with the National Museum of Denmark and the Nordic Heritage Museum of Seattle, Washington in mounting an exhibit on Danish folk costumes.

2005 – The Museum celebrates the bicentennial of Hans Christian Andersen's birth, hosts the annual meeting of the Federation of Danish Associations in Canada and co-sponsors the major conference, "Danish Culture, Past and Present: The Last Two Hundred Years". Museum quality lighting is installed in the mezzanine gallery, ultra-violet light filters are placed on all windows, and the Museum's roof is replaced with a new, red tile look.

2006 – The Museum celebrates the 10th anniversary of the Family History and Genealogy Center, initiates a Danish-American artists' series with new exhibits every six months, and unveils a redesigned website. Our first interns from American museum studies programs join the staff. Outreach programming includes a long-term residency with the University of Iowa's Maia String Quartet and cooperation with the Tempe Historical Museum through its Petersen House Museum. The Museum Shop is remodeled and the exterior of the museum is enhanced by treating exposed timbers and repainting.

2007 – Working with the Funen Graphic Workshop of Odense, Denmark, and the Nordic Heritage Museum in Seattle, the Museum arranges and co-sponsors a tour of contemporary Danish graphic art on the theme of immigration to Seattle, Solvang, Omaha, Des Moines, Minneapolis and Columbus, Ohio; the year's featured exhibit is "From Postcards to Instant Messaging: Family and Friends Stay in Touch; contemporary Danish artist Edward Matwijk and goldsmith Helle Jørvad exhibit their work and Jørvad presents a commissioned piece to the Bruce R. Lauritzen family in gratitude for their support; the Danish-American artists' series continues, featuring the work of Elmer Petersen and Cynthia McKeen; Humanities Iowa awards the Museum a grant to preserve audio interviews in digital format; the grand opening of the Jens Dixen House and the Cedar Valley Danes are celebrated; the Museum continues the Tribute to the Rescuers Essay Contest, its partnership with the Tempe City Museums, and its internship program with both Danish and American universities; the final unfinished area in the museum is remodeled into a kitchen and conference room.

The 2007-2008 Board of Directors is a special group of 22 men and women who have unselfishly dedicated themselves to the preservation of their Danish American heritage and the mission of the museum. They join an elite group of individuals who over the past 24 years have worked to build and maintain a museum of which all Danes, Danish Americans and the American public can be proud.

Participating at their own expense, the Board members come together three times a year to share their skills and experience in providing oversight to the administration of the museum and to develop ideas and plans that will contribute to its continuing vitality. 
